<p><b><u>Practice Test</u></b> Take a practice spelling test and have a family member check your work.</p>	<p><b><u>ABC Order</u></b> Write all your spelling words in ABC order twice.</p>	<p><b><u>Pyramid Words</u></b> Spell each one of your words, adding just one letter at a time so you make a pyramid Ex. c ca cap</p>
<p><b><u>Vowel Search</u></b> Write each word, circling all of the vowels.</p>	<p><b><u>Computer</u></b> Type your spelling words two times each. Make them funky fonts.</p>	<p><b><u>Silly Script</u></b> Write your spelling words once in regular print, and then again in a silly script</p>
<p><b><u>Rainbow Words</u></b> Write your words two times each in different colors. (You can use markers, pencils, crayons)</p>	<p><b><u>Phonics Party</u></b> Write your spelling words two times each.
